



Sips Panels Warranty and Disclaimer

Warranty Terms:

Super Panels Limited provides a 10-year warranty from the date of purchase, ensuring SIPS panels are free from defects due to factory workmanship or materials. The warranty is subject to the following conditions:

1. Claims Process:

- Claims require proof of purchase and a written claim within 30 days of defect discovery or before installation if known prior.

2. Remedy Options:

- Sole remedies include supplying replacement products, rectifying the affected product, or covering the cost of replacement or rectification.

3. Compliance Requirements:

- Projects must adhere to the NZ Building Code, regulations, and standards.

4. Installation and Maintenance:

- Strict adherence to relevant literature and manufacturer instructions for installation and maintenance is mandatory.

5. Limitation of Liability:

- Super Panels Limited's warranty excludes liability for specific claims, damages, or defects. These exclusions cover issues such as inadequate workmanship, flawed design, structural settlement or movement, improper structural design, unforeseeable acts of nature (such as earthquakes, cyclones, hurricanes), and any other circumstances beyond our reasonable control. - The warranty does not cover certain conditions such as normal wear and tear, the growth of mould, mildew, fungi, bacteria, or other organisms on the product surfaces.
